

The Repositories Renewal Project to identify and implement the next phase of the repository platform continues to progress well. In November, the upgrade of WREO (White Rose Etheses Online) onto the latest version of Eprints began, with a period of user testing by colleagues at the three institutions to test functionality. The move to the live server will be completed in the new year.


Following this, the migration of WRRO (White Rose Research Online) onto the new platform will commence, and will undergo the same process of updating and user testing by colleagues at the three sites.

## Research Organisation Registry



The Repositories Board approved the creation of a Research Organisation Registry (ROR) for WRL. ROR is an open persistent identifier which is used to identify organisations and connect research organizations to researchers and research outputs. This will allow WRL to connect to its parent institutions and the White Rose University Consortium, as well as link to concrete outputs and activities. As part of its creation, the Repositories Board will be identifying use cases and guidelines for use of the ROR.



Following a period of evaluation, the Repositories Board, supported by the White Rose Libraries Executive Board, approved in principle the renewal of WRL's CORE membership for another three years. The next iteration of membership will be at Supporting level, balancing WRL's commitment to financially support this important resource with the appropriate level of cost/value. CORE is a not-forprofit service which promotes discoverability of research and provides data on the repository contents and their reach. WRL is pleased to support the work of CORE through continued membership.


## WRRO - usage

# WRRO and WREO usage



On a national scale, WRRO and WREO's combined download totals make them the second most used repository platform in the UK, with a combined total of 1,326,030 downloads. # Next steps for WRL Repositories



### Repositories Renewal Project – WRRO upgrade

Work will continue in the new year on the repositories upgrade, with the full migration of WREO onto the new platform due at the beginning of January and WRRO soon to follow.

### MFA for repositories

Following the approval of the use of Multi Factor Authentication via institutional Single Sign On for the repositories, implementation of this will be factored into the White Rose workplan following the repositories upgrade.

#### **DOIs**

The Repositories Operational group continues to explore the automatic creation of DOIs for items and how best to incorporate these into the repositories workflows.

### **Learning Assets Repository**

The Board will continue discussions around a possible Learning Assets Repository and how this can be achieved.
