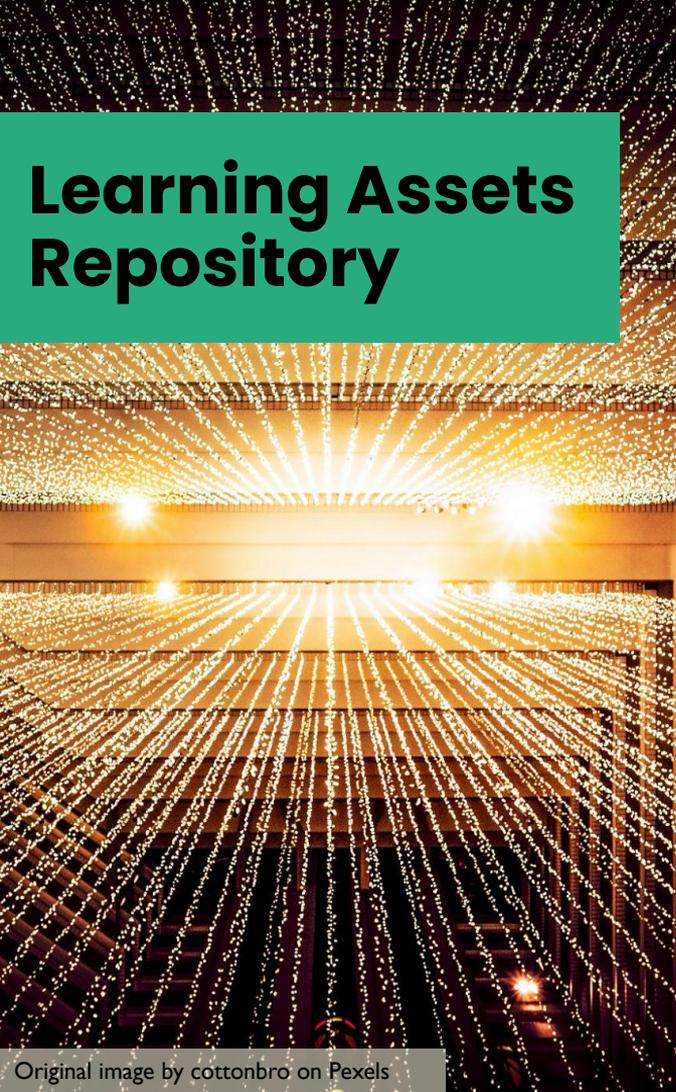

Learning Assets Repository

WLR Executive Board discussed the detailed proposal for WROLAR, and approved the development of a beta version of the platform in EPrints. This should allow colleagues to engage with the proposed platform and give feedback. It is still expected that, if finally approved, this will be delivered via a light-touch model based on existing sector practice to minimise staff resource through detailed in-platform guidance.

The technical support model will be defined during the project phase, with any additional local services determined at institutional discretion. Feedback will inform a final version, and any future development roadmap.

The platform would be offered initially as a pilot, and this will be reviewed to see if it will become an ongoing service.

AI Traffic



Issues with AI bot traffic continue to fluctuate. Members have consulted their institutions on CC Signals, which serves as machine-readable guidance—a community code of conduct rather than an enforceable licence—and would not prevent AI use if ignored by bots. The Repositories Board will recommend to the WRL Executive Board that this should be implemented.

One further impact of Bot traffic is that it makes usage stats previously used in reporting and advocacy unreliable as figures are now significantly skewed. This, coupled with the withdrawal of the IRUS service by Jisc will make reporting and demonstrating impact more difficult.

Membership Update

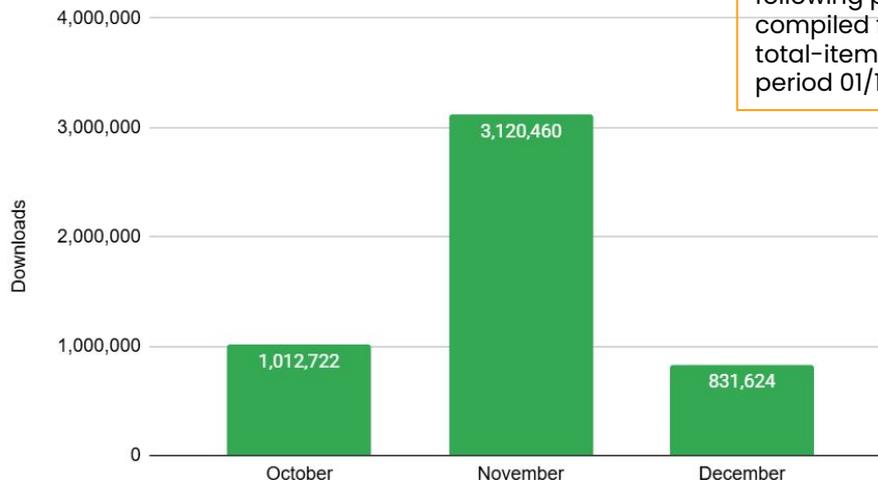

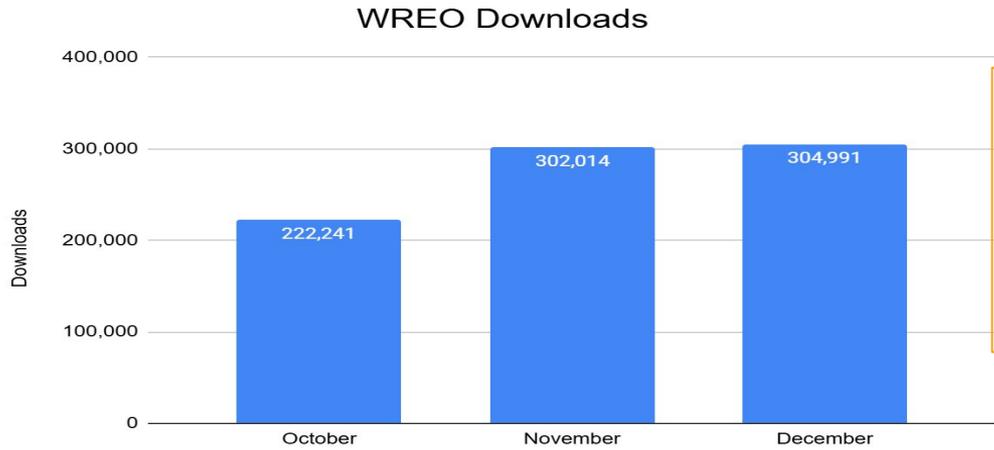

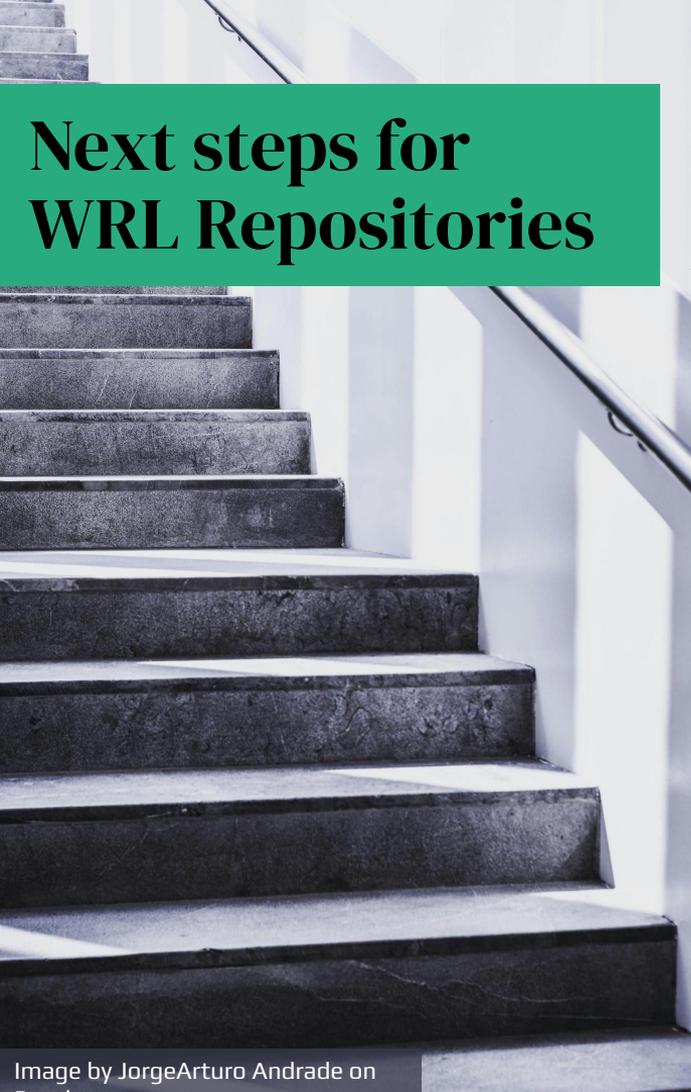

Next steps for WRL Repositories

Repositories Board Away Day

Plans are underway for a Repositories Board away day to create space for broader discussions, particularly around the WRL Strategy and the forthcoming Learning Assets Repository. This will be taken forward in 2026, with the March meeting extended to support this.

Open Repositories 2026

It was agreed that WRL should submit a paper to the Open Repositories 2026 conference. As the event will be virtual, this provides an opportunity to present the technical aspects of the project and related work, including repository infrastructure updates.

Engaging with the EPrints community

There was agreement that the EPrints community should be re-energised through a steering group. Initial enthusiasm has since slowed, likely due to reduced resources, time pressures, and sector restructuring, and reconnecting with the EPrints steering group was identified as a key next step.
